When children read at home, we ask an adult to sign the reading diary to say that they have listened to the child read.

Children in Y1/2 might also be listened to by a book buddy from Y5. The book buddy will sign to say that they have listened to the child read.

This is a space for parents/ carers to record a message to the class teacher or for the class teacher to record a message home. The teacher might also write a message here to remind children to read at home 3x a week.

Your child's teacher will sign to say that they have seen the diary. Our expectation is that they read at least 3x a week.
