Roseberry Primary School Roseberry Primary opened in September 2007 following the merger of Roseberry Infant and Junior School.

There are large grounds which are continually being developed to reflect our curriculum, interest in sustainability, the environment and healthy lifestyles. Our playgrounds, including our MUGA provide space and opportunities for different types of activity ensuring that all children have the opportunity to be actively engaged during playtimes.

There are 381 pupils on roll with a 38 place nursery operating am and pm. The school population is diverse with children from all types of social backgrounds leading to a lively, vibrant atmosphere. Attainment on entry is typically below average and the number of children known to be eligible for FSM/PP is significantly higher than the national average and within the Stockton area.

We are committed to raising standards of achievement particularly in the core areas and in basic skills enabling our children to make choices about their futures. A strong emphasis is also placed on sport, and creativity as we feel that our children respond well to these disciplines and that they have a positive impact on learning and behaviour.

The school serves the local community and has a tradition of educating generations of families. School and families support each other and work together in order to provide a cohesive environment for children to thrive in. We regularly hold events that enable families to join together to carry out activities based around a theme.
